## SECTION 1 – IMPORTANT GAMES INFORMATION

### 1.1 FACTS ABOUT THE SPECIAL OLYMPICS IX NATIONAL GAMES

From 19 – 24 April 2010, the city of Adelaide will welcome athletes from all Australian States and Territories for a week of companionship, excitement and competition at the Special Olympics Australia IX National Games.

Over 850 Special Olympics athletes and their coaches will be hosted at the official ‘Olympic Village’ at Adelaide Shores - one of South Australia’s premier holiday precincts.

The athletes will be accommodated, catered for and transported to and from the Olympic Village daily.

Athletes and their families / friends will have the opportunity to take part in the inspiring Official Opening Ceremony on Monday 19 April at the Distinctive Homes Dome and then enjoy 4 days of hotly contested competition in 11 Olympic sports and one demonstration sport at a range of quality venues around the city and suburbs of Adelaide. The event will culminate with an exciting Closing Ceremony on Friday 23 April at the Distinctive Homes Dome.

## 1. 3 ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES & SPECIAL EVENTS

In addition to the sports competition throughout the week, the Games will also provide;

### i) HEALTHY ATHLETES PROGRAM (HAP) proudly sponsored by Lions Australia



The internationally acclaimed **Healthy Athletes Program** will be conducted in the following disciplines;

- Opening Eyes – where eye and sight tests are completed
- Special Smiles – dental checks for athletes
- Healthy Hearing – where hearing and audio tests are completed
- Fit Feet – checking athletes walking process

Each of these clinics will be operated by health professionals along with support from volunteers and from Lions Australia. All competing athletes will take part in the Healthy Athletes Program and screening may also be available to non-competing Special Olympic athletes.

**Location:** The Shores Function Centre, Military Rd, West Beach

**Access:** Registered athletes and non competing Special Olympic athletes only

**Times:** To be advised.

### ii) OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY

The Official Opening Ceremony for the Special Olympics 2010 National Games will take place at the Distinctive Homes Dome – home of the Adelaide 36er's Basketball team.

Festivities will include the Athletes' march past, culmination of the Law Enforcement Torch Run, lighting of the cauldron, raising of the flag, official welcome and an array of entertainment.

**Date:** Monday 19 April 2010

**Location:** Distinctive Domes Home, 44a Crittenden Road, Findon

**Access:** Registered and ticketed athletes, families, supporters, sponsors and volunteers

**Times:** 4.30 pm – 6.30 pm

**Facilities:** Kiosk available for purchase of snack food and drinks

**Cost:** \$25 per person Family Tickets \$60 (max 4 from same family)


**Purchased tickets can be collected with your Welcome Pack at the Families Welcome Centre or (by prior arrangement only) at the venue on the day between 3.00pm – 4.00pm.**

- Transport:** Trams and buses run between Adelaide city and Glenelg.

**iv) PANDA-RING TO FAMILIES - WELCOME FUNCTION AT ADELAIDE ZOO proudly sponsored by**

- Location:** Adelaide Zoo, Frome Road, Adelaide
- Access:** Registered and ticketed families, supporters, sponsors and volunteers
- Times:** 5.30 pm – 8 pm
- Facilities:** Payment covers admittance to Zoo, including Panda reserve, access to Westpac Enviro-Dome, Entertainment, BBQ Dinner and Soft Drink. Alcoholic beverages can be purchased separately..
- Cost:** **\$15 per person      Family Ticket \$ 50 (max 4 from same family)**
- Transport:** Tram available from Glenelg to City, Buses, taxis or private vehicle.

**v) SIBLINGS SOCIAL PROGRAM**

The GOC is currently developing a Siblings Social Program for registered family members.

Full details and registration forms will be released in January 2010.

**vi) PRE & POST TOURING OPTIONS**

As the Special Olympics 2010 National Games conclude on the Anzac Day long weekend you may choose to stay on for a few days with your athlete and/or family and enjoy a taste of what South Australia has to offer.

A range of touring options, local attractions and tourism information is included in Section 2 of this document.

## **vii) CLOSING CEREMONY**

The Closing Ceremony for the Special Olympics 2010 National Games will take place at the Distinctive Homes Dome, Findon.

Festivities will include the Athlete's march past, dousing of the flame, lowering of the flag, circle of friends and an array of spectacular entertainment.

**Date:** Friday 23 April 2010

**Theme:** All the fun of the Circus!

**Location:** Distinctive Homes Dome, 44a Crittenden Road, Findon

**Access:** Registered and ticketed athletes, families, supporters, sponsors and volunteers

**Times:** 6.00 pm – 9.30 pm

**Facilities:** Kiosk available for purchase of snack food and drink

**Cost:** \$30 pp or Family Tickets (max 4) \$80

**Purchased tickets can be collected with your Welcome Pack at the Families Welcome Centre or (by prior arrangement only) at the venue on the day from 3.00pm – 4.00pm.**

**Please note, tickets must be pre-purchased and ticket sales will not be available on the night.**

**Transport:** By own arrangement. Limited public transport available so hire car/ bus or hire car/taxi is recommended.

## 1.4 DEFINITION OF A FAMILY MEMBER / SUPPORTER

The definition of a **family member or supporter** is an individual who is;

- The husband, wife or partner of the athlete
- A blood relative of the athlete (mother, father, child, sister, brother, grandparent, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, cousin, a relative related by marriage or a partner of a blood relative)
- An individual who serves as the athlete's legal guardian, foster parent, carer
- An individual involved with the athlete in a parenting role
- An individual involved with the athlete's competition preparation (coach, team member)
- A close friend of the athlete

## 1.5 FAMILIES & SUPPORTERS REGISTRATION

**Registration is essential for all family members and supporters** of athletes as it entitles them to certain privileges during the Special Olympics Australia 2010 National Games.

These privileges are granted to family members and supporters who register by the **18 December 2009** deadline.

These privileges include:

- A Welcome Pack upon arrival
- Free access to the Beachouse Families & Supporters Centre at Glenelg
- Free access to Families & Supporters Hospitality Areas at each sport competition venue
- An Accreditation pass (required for access to family activities)
- Provision of free public transport around Adelaide (by displaying official Accreditation pass)
- Reserved seating area at Opening & Closing Ceremonies (tickets to be purchased)
- Information about & access to Families & Supporters functions
- Access to nightly Happy Hour
- Siblings Social Program (user pays)

**The Families & Supporters Registration Form is included in this Guide.**

**Please note that only fully completed forms will be accepted.**

**The registration form is to be completed and returned with full payment for ticket purchases to the address provided by **18 December 2009**.**

***N.B. Family members or supporters who do not register by the deadline may attend as general spectators but will not be eligible for welcome packs, family activities, transport access or Family tickets to the Opening or Closing Ceremony.***

**Please note, tickets must be pre-purchased and ticket sales will not be available on the night.**

**Transport:** By own arrangement. Limited public transport is available so rental car/ bus or hire car/taxis are recommended.

## 1.6 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### ❖ What happens when I send in my family & supporter registration form?

After completing your registration form in full and attaching payment for any ticket or activities purchased, send your registration no later than **18 December 2009** to:

### **NOTE: ONLY COMPLETED FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AND FULL PAYMENT MUST ACCOMPANY EACH FORM**

Within 1 month of receiving your registration the 2010 GOC will send you a letter acknowledging receipt and advising of details for collection of tickets, family Welcome Packs etc.

### ❖ Will families have a reserved area for the Opening & Closing Ceremony

Yes. Reserved seating will be available to families & supporters who register. Ticket allocation for Official Functions and additional activities will be done on a first come first served basis so early registration is encouraged. Tickets will be available in Welcome Packs and/or for collection at the Families Welcome Centre.

**No tickets** will be available for sale at the door on the day of the Opening or Closing Ceremonies.

### ❖ What is Family Hospitality?

Family Hospitality is a facility at each competition venue open to registered family members and supporters only and will provide free tea and coffee and a place to relax and mingle with other family members.

### ❖ What is the Families & Supporters Centre?

The Families & Supporters Centre will be based at The Beachouse, Colley Terrace Glenelg, within 10 minutes drive of the Athletes Village and event hub of the Games.

The Centre will be open from 8.00 am to 7.00 pm Monday to Friday.

Services will include ticket and accreditation collection, distribution of Welcome Pack, games information, internet and email access, local attraction and visitor information and light refreshments.

It will also be the location of a nightly happy hour for registered families and supporters.

### ❖ Will day care be provided for children?

No. The 2010 Special Olympics Games will provide a number of family friendly activities including a sibling's social program which will be released in January 2010. In addition, children are welcome in the Family Hospitality areas and Families & Supporters Centre when supervised by their family.

### ❖ Will I have access to competing athletes during the games?

Procedures for family & supporter access to athletes will be defined and communicated by the Head of Delegation for each team. Families & supporters will NOT be allowed to enter the athlete accommodation or the meals areas at Adelaide Shores.

### ❖ **What special events are planned for families and supporters?**

In addition to the Opening & Closing Ceremonies families and supporters are encouraged to participate in the following activities;

- Panda-ring to Families at the Adelaide Zoo (Wed April 21 – 5.00 pm – 7.30 pm)
- Siblings Activities (Details to be released in January 2010)
- Families Happy Hour (Tues 20 – Thurs 22 April 5.00 pm – 7.00 pm at The Beachouse, Glenelg)
- Other activities as outlined in the official program.

### ❖ **Can I travel with the competing athletes to competition venues?**

No. Transport has been arranged for athletes and coaches ONLY. Families and supporters will be responsible for their own arrangements for transportation.

However, the South Australian Government, through the Minister for Transport, has decreed that registered families and supporters will have **free access via public transport** by presenting their accreditation. (note: without accreditation you will be unable to access this benefit). A public transport guide will be available in your welcome kit including information on bus schedules etc for sport venues.

Information on rental cars and taxis is also included in Section 2 of this guide.

### ❖ **When will I know the competition schedule?**

Competition programming is an ongoing process and monthly program updates will be available on the Special Olympics Australia website from October 2009.

Soccer - Tuesday 20/4 to Friday 23/4

Golf - Tuesday 20/4 to Friday 24/4 (incl wet weather contingency)

Gymnastics – Tuesday 20/4 – Wednesday 21/4

Sailing - Tuesday 20/4 to Friday 24/4 (incl wet weather contingency)

Softball - Tuesday 20/4 to Friday 24/4 (incl wet weather contingency)

Tennis - Tuesday 20/4 to Friday 24/4 (incl wet weather contingency)

Equestrian – Wed 21/4 to Friday 24/4

Final competition schedules will be available from the Family Centre and Family Hospitality areas at each venue during the Games.

❖ **What time will the Opening and Closing Ceremonies begin and end?**

The Opening Ceremony (Monday 19 April 2010) will commence at 4.30pm and end at 6.30pm.

The Closing Ceremony (Friday 23 April 2010) will commence at 6.00 pm and end at 9.30pm.

We recommend you arrive at the venue no less than 45 minutes prior to start time.

❖ **What transport is available to the Opening & Closing Ceremonies?**

There is limited public transport to the Distinctive Homes Dome. We strongly recommend you utilise taxis, hire cars, charter bus, rental car etc. Further transport information is available in Section 2 of this guide.

❖ **Is there a cost for tickets to competition venues?**

No. All sporting competitions are free and open to family members and supporters.

**Step 4 Your tickets will be held until the Games and may be collected at the Families Welcome Centre or by prior arrangement at the Opening Ceremony or Families Welcome Function.**

## SECTION 2 – GENERAL INFORMATION

### 2.1 ACCOMMODATION



**Please note that accommodation is by your own arrangement and will not be undertaken by the GOC.**

Special Olympics National Games Australia has appointed **Moves Travel** to act as our agent for all interstate transport, sightseeing and accommodation bookings.

Moves Travel will provide Special Olympics State Organisations with a cash sponsorship equating to 2% of overall flight, accommodation and ground transport revenue generated through Moves from the event. #### Accommodation Options

There are a wide range of accommodation options available close to all sporting venues. They include hotels, motels, serviced and self catering apartments, caravan parks and backpackers accommodation.

#### Locations

It is suggested that families and supporters base themselves at or near the seaside suburb of Glenelg (location of the Families and Supporters Centre & Nightly Happy Hour) or in the City of Adelaide which has direct tram access to and from Glenelg.

Given the popularity of the Glenelg area as a tourist destination it is advisable that you book as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

## 2.2 TRANSPORT

Please note that all transport is by your own arrangement and is not organised by the GOC.

**However, the South Australian Government has agreed that all registered families and supporters of the Special Olympics 2010 National Games can access free public transport for the week of the Games. You must show your official Games accreditation (supplied on arrival) to be eligible for free transport.**

### Adelaide Airport

Adelaide Airport is 7kms west of the city centre and reasonably close to the Adelaide Shores “Olympic Village” complex. Buses connect to the city and taxis, hire cars and rental cars are available. A **Games Welcome Booth** will be located on the ground floor of the Adelaide Airport (near the baggage collection area) for your enquiries.

### Bus Service

Adelaide has an extensive bus service network which operates within Adelaide and suburbs. ### Trains

There are 5 suburban train lines which emanate from the Adelaide Central Railway Station on North Terrace (next to Sky City casino). ### Glenelg Tram

Trams run regularly between Glenelg and the City. Travel is free between South Terrace and West Terrace (the city square). Normal fares apply outside of the city square but the SA Government has agreed that people with Special Games Accreditation can travel free. Trams run every 7 minutes in peak time and every 15 mins off peak.

### Metro Tickets and Timetables

Two hour tickets can be purchased from bus drivers, tram conductors or ticket machines on trains. If you intend to regularly use public transport the most economical way to travel is by purchasing a “Multi-trip” ticket which gives you 10 trips at about 60% of normal fares.
